

MEDICATIONS CONTAINING ANTIHISTAMINES

The following is a list of medications that can affect allergy skin testing. Allergy, cold, sleep aids, antacid, anti-nausea and anti-depressant medications frequently contain antihistamines. Below is a list of generic medications (brand names in parenthesis). STOP THE BELOW MEDICATIONS AT LEAST 4 DAYS PRIOR TO TESTING

Diphenhydramine (Benadryl, Advil PM, Tylenol PM, Excedrin PM, ZzzQuil)
Doxylamine (NyQuil, Tylenol Cold Nighttime, Unisom)
Fexofenadine (Allegra)
Hydroxyzine (Atarax, Vistaril)
Levocetirizine (Xyzal)
Loratadine (Claritin)
Methdilazine (Tacaryl)
Olopatadine (Patanase)

Antacid/anti-nausea medications

Cimetidine (Tagamet)
Dimenhydrinate (Dramamine)
Famotidine (Pepcid)
Meclizine (Bonine, Antivert)
Nizatidine (Axid)
Promethazine (Phenergan)
